

Health Standard for Boarding Pets

We want every pet to have a comfortable stay while boarding with us.

However, some pets are not suitable for boarding at our facility.

This may be due to certain behavior issues, health conditions and/or their advanced age.

Whether or not a pet is suitable for boarding is decided by one of the doctors on a case-by-case basis for each pet.

In general, boarders must be able to stand and walk on their own, and generally tolerate being in an environment with other pets.

Puppies and kittens that are current on vaccinations are welcome to board with us and stay in an area made just for them.

Adult Boarders must be fully vaccinated based on our hospital's vaccination requirements and our standards of care.

If for any reason we determine your pet would not do well in the boarding environment, we will give you a full explanation, and offer alternatives.
