


Conveniently located in Myrtle Beach off Hwy 17 Bypass South and 544 South





The Animal Emergency Hospital of the Strand is proud to bring Advanced 3D Imaging to the Grand Strand.

Our Vimago unit provides a greater resolution than traditional CT which gives excellent details of the internal anatomy and significantly more information than a radiograph.

The CT Scans are read by a board certified radiologist who will provide their report within a few hours\* of receiving the study.

CT Scans may be conducted on more than one study site and can be helpful in identifying apparent anomalies in the body, detecting or ruling out tumors and cancers, and even preparing for surgery. A scan can be especially helpful in evaluating nasal, brain, and spinal disease as well as understanding orthopedic anomalies and much more.



Pet parents will receive CT scan results on a USB jump drive with a program that will enable them to view their pet's CT Scan. Due to the large file size from hundreds of images, CT Scans cannot be emailed.

CT Scans are performed during normal hours of operation. CT Scan patients must be admitted to the hospital as the scan will require sedation. Please be advised that during times of high case volume, CT Scans will be performed after emergencies are stabilized.
